# MATHEMATICS

#### Counting

SUPER SKILLS

I can count up to a given amount up to 10. I can count up to 10 objects. I can recognise when a ten frame is full. I can identify a set that has more or fewer. I can order numbers 0-10. I can count backwards from a given number. KNITTED KNOWLEDGE I recognise numerals 0-10. I know how to count in the correct order. I recognise more and less. I know how to count forwards and backwards. Shape SUPER SKTLLS I can recognise and name 3D shapes (cube, cuboid, sphere, cone, cylinder, pyramid). I can use mathematical language to describe 3D shapes (curved, pointed, sides, faces, solid, flat and vertex/vertices (corners on 3D)). KNITTED KNOWLEDGE I have an understanding that faces and solid refer to 3D shapes and I can identify and talk about these on common 3D shapes.

I know how to count faces and vertices.

# **UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD**

#### Use technology purposefully.

SUPER SKILLS I can use the I-pads to access 'Mathseeds'. I understand how to use the i-pads correctly and safely. I can programme a robot. KNITTED KNOWLEDGE I know when I have completed the set task. I know how to get a robot from one place to another.
