

For those parents new to the school, hello and welcome. A little background: the Home and School Association or HSA was set up in September 2018. Our aim is to raise much needed funds and to help provide additional resources required to make the learning and social activities experienced by our children as rewarding as possible.

We are a friendly, enthusiastic team determined to support the great work of our brilliant school. Events we have organised to date were designed with fun in mind and the involvement of the children, parents, families and wider community are very important to us.

Childrens' events have included: non-uniform days; a super Sport-a-thon; a cinema evening (complete with popcorn!) plus amazing Christmas parties and discos to name but a few. And not to leave the adults out, we have hosted a wonderful Christmas shopping evening, a fabulous Fashion show, a stunning Art exhibition and several Lucky Squares games and raffles.

The money raised, including some very generous donations from local businesses, has paid for equipment including a digital data logger, a green screen and over 100 new books for the school library. With funds raised through the last academic year, we had 100 square grids professionally painted on the infant and junior yards during lockdown, which the children are now having great fun playing on. Our current plans are to update school sports strips and P.E. equipment and to setup of a 'Forest School' area (a very exciting project!) with money pledged through the Co-op Community Fund (details overleaf). Together we ARE making a difference.



Another event, currently live on Facebook, is an online virtual Christmas Market – please see attached poster – which we would be delighted if you could support. Future planning and events will take place as soon as it is safe and appropriate. HSA news is regularly updated on the noticeboard on the infant yard wall (directly in front of you as you enter via the gate) and via the link on the school website, so please have a read when you can. The current Co-op local community giving period for our Forest School project has come to an end. Thank you to everyone who chose us as their cause, together we have raised over £1,400 which is incredible under the circumstances, and will go a long way towards the initial set up of this area.
