Last week I wrote to you to let you know that this week's assemblies would be quite different and this is because they are linked to Internet Safety Day on Tuesday. Later today we will upload three assemblies onto our website, in the 'Whole School' section of Home Learning. Each of these assemblies will be suitable for different age groups and will be clearly labelled as such.

Internet safety is of great importance to all of us at St. Michael's, and I know it is also a concern for many of you. I would strongly recommend that you access one of the assemblies as each one contains very important messages for both our children and us as parents. However, I would encourage you to either watch the assemblies with your children or view them first. This is especially the case for the video aimed at our older children which contains some quite hard-hitting messages. We suggest that you make yourself aware of video's content before your child watches it. These are all videos that we would use in school, but, obviously, not in isolation; they would be backed up with discussion and opportunities for questions.

On the videos, Miss Rowe suggests some follow up activities for the children, please note these are entirely optional, so please do not feel under any pressure to complete them.

This week's Zoom sessions for our Junior children will also have an Internet Safety theme.
