



Year 2 Home Learning:

<u>ENGLISH</u> Reading	<p>Try to read for 20 minutes a day.</p> <p>See the VIPERS document below for some questions you could talk about with an adult, linked to your book.</p> <p>Remember you can access e books from the Oxford Owl website. You can access this resource by clicking on the link below and creating a parent log in.</p> <p>Can you write a book review of your favourite book? Why is it your favourite? Can you try to persuade a friend from school to read it in your review?</p>
Writing	<p>How to make a Paper Crown - instructions</p> <p>In this unit of work there are 10 lessons, each with a video. We hope you enjoy learning about writing instructions.</p> <p>Can you write a set of instructions in order to make a paper crown?</p> <p>You will also explore and identify 'bossy' verbs to help you write instructions.</p> <p>Do you think you might be able to sequence your instructions and orally tell your mum or dad?</p>
Spelling	<p>Choose 10 words from the Year 1 or Year 2 word list that you find tricky to spell. Can you write these words in rainbow colours? What else can you do to help you remember these spellings? Can you see a pattern in the word or a word within the word? Headlines</i></p><p><i>Cut letters out of magazines and newspapers to spell your words. That's an order!</i></p><p><i>Write your words out in alphabetical order.</i></p></div></div> <p>Try to spend 15 minutes practising your spellings every day.</p>
